

- (2) For first stage of conversion to adapt an existing institution for use as a Training School for Older Boys, including equipment (initial capacity 76), PROVIDED, THAT NONE OF THE FUNDS PROVIDED FOR HEREIN MAY BE USED FOR THE PURPOSE OF NEW CONSTRUCTION, IMPROVEMENTS OR RENOVATIONS AT THE HENRYTON STATE HOSPITAL; AND PROVIDED FURTHER, THAT THIS APPROPRIATION SHALL NOT BE EXPENDED PRIOR TO ADJOURNMENT OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE 1962 GENERAL ASSEMBLY 363,500
- (3) TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF CONSTRUCTING A CONVENTION HALL IN OCEAN CITY, MARYLAND 5,000
- (4) FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING LAND IN THE PATUXENT RIVER WATERSHED, EITHER BY OUTRIGHT STATE PURCHASE OR THROUGH THE EQUAL MATCHING OF FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ONE OR MORE OF THE SEVERAL COUNTIES IN WHICH THE WATERSHED IS LOCATED 150,000
- (5) TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF DEVELOPING A STATE PARK OR RECREATIONAL AREA ON TUCKAHOE CREEK, WHERE IT FORMS THE BOUNDARY BETWEEN CAROLINE AND QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTIES, INCLUDING ENGINEERING STUDIES FOR DETERMINING THE FEASIBILITY OF CONSTRUCTING A DAM.. 5,000
- (6) TO PAY PART OF THE COST OF CONSTRUCTING A BRIDGE OVER SINEPUXENT BAY BETWEEN ASSATEAGUE ISLAND AND THE MAINLAND OF WORCESTER COUNTY; CONTINGENT UPON THE ENACTMENT OF BOTH SENATE BILL NO. 321 AND SENATE BILL NO. 322 OF THE 1961 REGULAR SESSION..... 500,000
