## House Bill No. 245—Hunting and Fishing Licenses

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 129(b) and 221(d) of Article 66C of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1960 Supplement), title "Natural Resources", sub-title "Birds, Game and Inland Water Fish", sub-headings "Hunter's License" and "Game and Fresh Water Fish", making provision for hunting and fishing licenses which have been sold to an agent and which are lost or out of the agent's possession by certain causes beyond his control and providing for procedure whereby the agent may be reimbursed for the cost of the licenses.

Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17, of the Maryland Constitution, I am returning to you herewith House Bill No. 245 which has been vetoed by me.

The Bill is intended to provide a procedure whereby agents who have purchased hunting and fishing licenses from the Department of Game and Inland Fish for resale to the public may be reimbursed for licenses which, prior to sale by the agents, have been lost, stolen,
