(F) THE AUTHORITY MAY BE GRANTED UNDER THE
TERMS OF THIS ACT TO A DOCTOR OF MEDICINE AS DE-
FINED HEREIN FOR THE USE OF THE ENTIRE BODY OF
ANY PERSON FOR MEDICAL EDUCATION, RESEARCH AND
STUDY IN THE SAME MANNER AND FORM AS PROVIDED
BY THE PREVIOUS SECTIONS; EXCEPT THAT THE AU-
THORITY GRANTED BY AN INSTRUMENT FOR THIS PUR-
POSE MAY BE REVOKED BY ACTUAL NOTICE TO THE
HOLDER OF THE BODY WITHIN SEVENTY-TWO HOURS
AFTER DEATH BY A PARENT, SPOUSE, CHILD, BROTHER
OR SISTER OF THE DECEASED.

(G) NOTHING IN THIS ACT SHALL INVALIDATE ANY AU-
THORITY OR INSTRUMENT EXECUTED PRIOR TO THE EF-
FECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT.
