property while hunting thereon, and the landowner shall not be liable for any ACCIDENTAL injury or damage to such person, whether or not the landowner or his agent gave permission to hunt thereon.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1961.

CHAPTER 332

(Senate Bill 360)

AN ACT to add a new Section 37 to Article 1A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Aeronautics", and to follow immediately after Section 36 thereof, and to be under the new sub-title "Rules and Regulations", authorizing the governing body of any publicly-owned airport to adopt, amend and enforce rules and regulations relating to parking of motor vehicles, the movement of traffic, safety at the airport, and the preservation of order with respect to the airport, SPECIFYING CERTAIN PROCEDURES FOR THE ADOPTION OF THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS, and providing penalties for violations of said rules and regulations.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a new Section 37 be and it is hereby added to Article 1A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Aeronautics", to follow immediately after Section 36 thereof, to be under the new sub-title "Rules and Regulations", and to read as follows:

The governing body of any publicly-owned airport in the State of Maryland shall have the power, AFTER HOLDING A PUB-LIC HEARING THEREON, to adopt, amend and enforce rules and regulations relating to the parking of motor vehicles, the movement of traffic, safety at the airport, and the preservation of order with respect to the airport. Any person who violates any rule or regulation adopted pursuant to the provisions of this section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof in a court of the jurisdiction in which the airport is located, shall be fined not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), or imprisoned not more than three (3) months, or both.; BUT IN NO EVENT SHALL ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES A PARKING REGULATION ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SEC-TION BE SUBJECTED TO A PENALTY OTHER THAN A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$10.00; AND PROVIDED FURTHER THAT ALL OF SAID RULES AND REGULATIONS SHALL BE FIRST CONSPICUOUSLY POSTED IN A PUBLIC PLACE ON THE PREMISES.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1961.
