SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1961.*

CHAPTER 390

(Senate Bill 349)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 8-11 of the Frederick County Code—1959, being Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title “Frederick County”, sub-title “Part I. General Local Laws”, sub-heading “Finance and Taxation”, regarding discount of Frederick County taxes paid on or before the last day of December.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 8-11 of the Frederick County Code—1959, being Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title “Frederick County”, sub-title “Part I. General Local Laws”, sub-heading “Finance and Taxation”, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:*

8-11.

The County Commissioners are authorized and empowered, in their discretion, to allow a discount not exceeding five per cent upon all county taxes paid on or before the ~~first day of July~~ *last day of December* in each year after the date of their levy and to provide in their county levy for such discount.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1961.*
