CEPT THAT IN THE HANCOCK ELECTION DISTRICT OF WASH-INGTON COUNTY, THE COMMIS-SION MAY REDUCE THE DEER POPULATION IN AREAS SUFFER-ING FROM CROP DAMAGE AFTER THOROUGH INVESTIGATION SHOWS THAT SUCH ACTION IS JUSTIFIED. THE METHOD OF RE-DUCING THE DEER POPULATION SHALL BE AT THE DISCRETION OF THE COMMISSION EXCEPT THATWHEREVER FEASIBLE TRAPPING SHALL BE PREFER-RED. THE DEER WHICH MAY BE TAKEN UNDER THIS PROVISION SHALL BE DISPOSED OF BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE COMMISSION AS HE MAY DEEM ADVISABLE AND FOR THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE STATE. IN DORCHESTER. MARY'S, SOMERSET. COMICO AND WORCESTER COUN-TIES, THERE SHALL BE A THREE-DAY OPEN SEASON FOR ANT-LERLESS DEER BEGINNING ON A SATURDAY PRIOR TO NOVEM-BER 15 OF EACH YEAR, AS ES-TABLISHED FROM TIME TO TIME BY THE COMMISSION; AND PER-MITS ARE REQUIRED FOR THIS PRIVILEGE IN SAID COUNTIES. WHICH SHALL BE ISSUED WITH-OUT CHARGE AND ONLY TO RESIDENTS AND LANDOWNERS OF THE SAID COUNTIES. IN AL-LEGANY COUNTY, THERE SHALL BE NO PERIOD FOR HUNTING ANTLERLESS DEER UNLESS THE MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION FROM THE GEOGRAPHICAL SEC-TION EMBRACING THE COUNTY AGREES TO SUCH A PERIOD.

(d) It shall be unlawful to hunt or kill any game on Sundays [or when the ground is covered with snow; provided, however, it]. It shall be lawful to hunt [wild waterfowl] game when the ground is covered with snow.

The bag limits per day for game birds and game animals shall be set by regulation of the Game and Inland Fish Commission under authority conferred upon it by Section 115 of this article [and said daily bag limits shall not exceed the numbers hereinafter enumerated].
