The sizes and creel limits per day for game and fresh water fish shall be set by regulation of the Game and Inland Fish Commission under authority conferred upon it by Section 115 of this article [within the prescribed limits listed below]. The Game and Inland Fish Commission shall adopt and publish sizes, creel and possession limits on game and fresh water fish annually on or before October 25 for the ensuing calendar year.
