visions of this section, each defendant, FOUND GUILTY in any criminal case in the magistrates courts, shall pay a fee of four dollars (\$4.00).

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1961.

CHAPTER 510

(House Bill 421)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 20 of Article 36 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1960 Supplement), title "Fees of Officers", sub-title "Justices of the Peace", prescribing fees to be paid upon the filing of suits in the Magistrates Courts of Anne Arundel County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 20 of Article 36 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1960 Supplement), title "Fees of Officers", sub-title "Justices of the Peace", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
