be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

37.

- (d) Calvert County.—The Sheriff of Calvert County shall receive an annual salary of \$\[\frac{1}{3},000 \] \$\[\frac{5}{3},000 \] and \$\[\frac{1}{3},000 \] \$\[\frac{2}{3},000 \] for all expenses \$\[\frac{1}{6}\$, which may be increased or decreased in the discretion of the County Commissioners \]. The said sheriff shall appoint \$\[\frac{1}{6}\$ adeputy sheriffs to serve at the pleasure of said Sheriff and under his direction. \$\[\frac{1}{6}\$ The deputy shall receive as a minimum the salary and the allowances for traveling, uniforms, arms, equipment and expenses which were being received by the special police officer in Prince Frederick and vicinity immediately prior to March 1, 1951 \]. Each deputy sheriff shall receive an annual salary in the amount of \$\[\frac{1}{2}\$,000 and an allowance for expenses in an annual amount of \$\[\frac{1}{2}\$,000.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That nothing in this Act shall be construed or applied to affect the salary of the Sheriff of Calvert County who holds this position on the effective date of this Act, for the remainder of the term in which he then is serving. The increase in salary herein provided for the Sheriff of Calvert County shall first become effective at the beginning of the term of the Sheriff who is elected to that position at the time of the regular elections in the month of November, 1962.
- SEC. 3. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1961.

CHAPTER 522

(House Bill 476)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 3 (f) and 265 of Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Elections", sub-title respectively "Supervisors of Elections and Employees" and "Servicemen's Absentee Voting", and to add new Section 5 (i) to the said Article of the Code, sub-title "Supervisors of Elections and Employees", to follow immediately after Section 5 (h) thereof, to change the annual salary and other compensation of the Board of Supervisors of Elections of Calvert County and to fix the salary of the clerk to the Board.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 3 (f) and 265 of Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Elections", sub-titles respectively "Supervisors of Elections and Employees" and "Servicemen's Absentee Voting", be and they are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with
