SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1961.

CHAPTER 526

(House Bill 499)

AN ACT to add a new Section 104 (c-1) to Article 52 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Justices of the Peace", sub-title "Trial Magistrates System", to follow immediately after Section 104 (c) thereof, to provide that in Cecil County one-half of all costs, fees, fines, penalties and forfeitures collected by trial magistrates shall be paid to the several incorporated municipalities of the county, respectively, if the arrest in a particular case was made by police officers of the respective municipalities.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That a new Section 104 (c-1) be and it is hereby added to Article 52 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Justices of the Peace", sub-title "Trial Magistrates System", to follow immediately after Section 104 (c) thereof, and to read as follows:

(c-1). In Cecil County, one-half of all costs, fees, fines, penalties and forfeitures shall be paid to the several incorporated municipalities of the county, respectively, if the arrest in a particular case was made by the municipal police.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1961.
