

CHAPTER 534

(House Bill 545)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 112 (b) of Article 52 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Justices of the Peace", sub-title "Trial Magistrates System", to change the compensation of the clerical assistants to the trial magistrates of Charles County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 112 (b) of Article 52 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Justices of the Peace", sub-title "Trial Magistrates System", be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

112.

(b) In Charles County, clerical assistants shall be appointed by the trial magistrates of said county, and shall, on and after January 1, ~~1959~~ 1961, receive an annual compensation ~~[of \$3,000]~~ *not exceeding three thousand and six hundred dollars (\$3,600.00).*

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1961.

CHAPTER 535

(House Bill 558)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 51 (g) of Article 25 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "County Commissioners", sub-title "County Treasurers", to increase the salary of the County Treasurer and Deputy Treasurer of Charles County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 51 (g) of Article 25 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition) title "County Commissioners", sub-title "County Treasurers", be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

51 (g).

The county treasurer of Charles County shall receive an annual salary of ~~[\$5,000.00]~~ *\$6,000.00.* The salary of the assistant treasurer shall ~~[be \$3,000.00]~~ *not exceed \$3,600.00* per annum.
