MENTS SUPPORTING THE GOVERNOR'S BUDGET SUBMITTAL FOR THE 1962 FISCAL YEAR; AND SUCH REPORT SHALL INCLUDE THE JUSTIFICATION FOR ADDING SUCH POSITIONS TO THE BUDGET.

AND PROVIDED FURTHER, THAT THE STATE COMMISSIONER OF PERSONNEL SHALL SEND TO THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL EACH MONTH A LIST OF THE RECLASSIFICATION ACTIONS APPROVED IN THE PREVIOUS MONTH SHOWING THE TITLE AND SALARY OF THE POSITION BEFORE AND AFTER RECLASSIFICATION AND GIVING THE JUSTIFICATION FOR THE RECLASSIFICATION.

AND PROVIDED FURTHER, THAT THE STATE EMPLOY-EES' STANDARD SALARY BOARD SHALL SEND TO THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL EACH MONTH A STATEMENT SHOW-ING EACH SALARY ADJUSTMENT APPROVED IN THE PRE-CEDING MONTH BY THE GOVERNOR TOGETHER WITH THE REASONS FOR THE BOARD'S RECOMMENDATION TO THE GOVERNOR FOR APPROVAL OF SUCH ACTION.

SEC. 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT NO FUNDS APPROPRIATED IN THIS ACT SHALL BE AVAILABLE FOR THE PURCHASE, MAINTENANCE OR OPERATION OF ANY MOTOR VEHICLE WHICH IS USED FOR PERSONAL PURPOSES. FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS SECTION, THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS IS HEREBY DIRECTED TO ESTABLISH NECESSARY RULES AND REGULATIONS TO DETERMINE COMPLIANCE HEREWITH.
