

If a mans labour be employed in Hempt and Flake, it will yeeld him as much profit, as *Tobacco* at this rate; and so in many other Commodities, whereof this Countrey is capable.

No man neede to doubt of the vent of these Commodities, for Merchants send shipping to those parts, who will buy off these Commodities at the aforesaid rates, in as great a quantity, as they shalbe able to make ready for them; because they yeeld a great encrease of profit in other Countreys, which the Planters themselves may make aduantage of to themselves, if they have shipping, and thinke fit to deale in such a kind of trade. As for instance, a 1000. of Pipe-staves, which are rated upon the place at four pound, being carried to the *Canaries*, will yeeld 15. or 20. l. Where likewise, and at the Westerne Islands, the *Indian Corne* will yeeld a great increase of benefit. The benefit also which may be raised by trade out of Swine onely, may easily be conceived to be very great, seeing they multiplie exceedingly, aske little tendance, and lesse charge of keeping in that Countrey, so abounding with Mast, Chestnuts, &c. For Porke being transported into *Spaine*, or the Westerne Islands will yeeld about 6. pence a pound, and Bacon, 8. pence. or 9. pence.
