of *Windsor*, in Our County of *Berkshire*, in free and common foccage, by fealty onely, for all seruices, and not in Capite, or by Knights seruice : YEELDING and paying therefore to Vs, our Heires and Successors, two *Indian* Arrowes of those parts, to be delivered at Our said Castle of *Windsor*, every yeere on the Tuesday in *Easter* weeke ; and also the fifth part of all Gold and Siluer Oare within the limits aforesaid, which shall from time to time happen to be found.

NOW THAT the said Countrey thus by Vs granted, and described, may be eminent above all other parts of the said territory, and dignified with larger titles : Know yee that wee of our further grace, certaine knowledge, and meere motion, have thought fit to erect the same Countrey and Ilands into a Province, as out of the fullnesse of Our royall Power, and Prerogative, Wee doe, for Vs, Our Heires, and Successors, erect, and incorporate them into a Province, and doe call it *Mary land*, and so from henceforth will have it called.

AND FORASMUCH as Wee have hereby made, and ordained the foresaid now Lord *Baltimore*, the true Lord, and Proprietary of all the Province aforesaid : Know yee therefore moreover, that Wee, reposing especiall trust and confidence in the fidelitie, wisdome, Iustice, and Provident
