dent circumspection of the said now Lord Powerto er Baltemore, for Vs, Our Heires and Successors, nat Lawes. doe grant free, full, and absolute power, by vertue offere Presents, to him and his heires, for the good and happy government of the faid Province, to ordaine, make, enact, and under his and their seales to publish any Lawes whatfoever, appertaining either unto the publike State of the said Province, or unto the private utility of particular Persons, according unto their best discretions, of and with the adulta affent and approbation of the Free-men of the said Province, or the greater part of them, or of their delegates or deputies, whom for the enacting of the faid Lawes, when, and as often as neede shall require, We will that the said now Lord Battemere, and his heires, shall assemble in such sort and forme, as to him or them shall seeme best: And the same lawes duly to execute upon all people, within the said Province, and limits thereof, for the time being, or that shall be constituted under the government, and power of him or them, either fayling towards Mary-land, or returning from thence toward England or any other of Ours, or forraine Dominions, by imposition of Penalties, Imprisonment, or any other punishment: yea, if it shall be needfull, and that the quality of the offence require it, by taking away memberor life, either by him the faid now Lord Baltemore.
