

Also House Bill No. 808, entitled "An Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Talbot county to appoint a county game warden and to define the duties and obligations of such officer; to provide ways and means for the compensation of such official; to provide for the propagation and protection of game and fish in said county." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Fish and Game.*]

Also House Bill No. 755, entitled "An Act to repeal and reenact, with amendments, the charter of the town of Brunswick, in Frederick county, as said charter was enacted by Chapter 495 of the Acts of General Assembly of Maryland of 1898 and amended by Chapter 482 of the Acts of General Assembly of 1900, and by Chapter 520 of the Acts of General Assembly of 1904, and by Chapter 158 of the Acts of General Assembly of 1908, and by Chapters 511 and 601 of the Acts of General Assembly of 1910, and by Chapter 660 of the Acts of General Assembly of 1912, and by Chapters 20 and 180 of the Acts of General Assembly of 1914." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Kaufman, Bomberger and Warfield.*]

Also House Bill No. 863, entitled "An Act authorizing the trustees of the Patapsco Academy, in Anne Arundel county, to sell same and to apply the proceeds therefrom to the payment of accrued expenses, including expense of sale and transfer, not exceeding two hundred and fifty dollars, and the balance to pay to the County School Commissioners of Anne Arundel county to be applied by them to the purposes of a new school in said locality, as herein provided." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.*]

Also House Bill No. 857, entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 27 of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Crimes and Punishments,' sub-title 'Fraud,' to be known as Section 119-D of said Article." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.*]
