Amendments proposed by Mr. Collier:

No. 1—"Strike out the following words from lines 2 and 3 of the title to the printed Bill, to wit: 'to build and construct an improved road from the town of Easton to Claiborne in Talbot county, and,' and insert in lieu thereof the following words: 'in its discretion.'"
