

Also House Bill No. 317, entitled "An Act to add a section to Article 75 of Bagby's Annotated Code of Public General Laws, title 'Pleadings, Practice and Process at Law;' said section to follow immediately after Section 23 of said Article and to be designated as Section 23-A, concerning suits by and against joint stock companies or unincorporated associations." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.*]

Also House Bill No. 677, entitled "An Act to re-establish, survey and mark the boundary lines between Prince George's and Charles counties, where same are not now clearly defined." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Holmead, Johnson and Warfield.*]

Also House Bill No. 249, entitled "An Act to provide for a State subscription to Joseph's 'Contest of Wills,' providing for a distribution thereof and an appropriation for the subscription." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.*]

Also House Bill No. 558, entitled "An Act to authorize and direct the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Talbot county to have a new index of the land records of said county from the settlement of the county to the year 1833 made on the Campbell System, and to direct the Board of County Commissioners of said county to levy a sum of money to pay therefor." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.*]

Also House Bill No. 899, entitled "An Act to direct and require the Governor of the State of Maryland to appoint the same persons upon both the Board of Trustees of the Maryland State College of Agriculture and the State Board of Agriculture so that said Boards will be one and the same." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Agriculture.*]

Also House Bill No. 398, entitled "An Act to repeal Sections 21-B and 21-C of Article 56 as the same are numbered and set forth in the Annotated Code of Maryland, as legalized by Chapter 21 of the Acts of 1912 and Chapter 16 of the Acts of 1914, of the General Assembly of Maryland, title 'Licenses,' sub-title 'Brokers,' and re-enact the same with
