Also House Bill No. 877, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 93 of Article 23 of the Code of Public General Laws of the State of Maryland, title 'Corporations,' sub-title 'Foreign Corporations.'" [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Insurance, Fidelity, Security and Loan Companies.*]

Also House Bill No. 889, entitled "An Act requiring the State Roads Commission of Maryland to take over and include in the State roads system the public road leading from Aberdeen, in Harford county, to Cowenton, in Baltimore county, known as the Philadelphia Post Road." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Roads and Highways.*]

Also House Bill No. 277, entitled "An Act to repeal Sections 9 to 49, both inclusive, of Article 48, as the same are numbered and set forth in the Annotated Code of Maryland, as legalized by Chapter 21 of the Acts of 1912 and Chapter 16 of the Acts of 1914 of the General Assembly of Maryland, title 'Inspection,' sub-title 'Tobacco,' and re-enact the same, with amendments." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Inspections.*]

Also House Bill No. 879, entitled "An Act to repeal Chapter 770 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session, 1912, title 'An Act to repeal Chapter 720 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session, 1910, title "Charles County," sub-title "LaPlata," and to re-enact the following in lieu thereof, and to submit this Act to the registered and qualified voters of the town of LaPlata for their acceptance or rejection as the charter of said town." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Mudd, Chesley and Joy.*]
