

That the Big Rock Water Company, of Baltimore City, be paid \$113 for drinking water furnished to General Assembly.

That the Individual Drinking Cup Company be paid \$54 for furnishing drinking cups.

That the members on Committee of Printed or Engrossed Bills be paid the sum of \$200 each (there being four on committee; total amount, \$800).
