SUBJECT: STATE ROADS COMMISSION ESTABLISH A FERRY FROM CLAIBORNE TO ANNAPOLIS.

[Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays, as amended."]

Amendment proposed by House of Delegates: "Strike out all of Section 2 of the Bill, as printed for third reading and insert in lieu thereof the following:

'Section 2. And be it further enacted, That the sum of fifty thousand (\$50,000) be and the same is hereby appropriated for the purpose of carrying out and making effective the provisions of this Act; provided, however, that said sum hereby appropriated shall not be available unless and until the State Roads Commission shall in the exercise of their discretion establish the ferry hereby authorized.'"
