

Also unfavorably the following order by Mr. Duvall: Ordered, That Jacob Frazier, Reginald Geraci and Harry Rosati, messengers to the telephone exchange, be paid the sum of twenty-five dollars (\$25) each for services rendered to the Senate of 1916; to be taken from appropriation for legislative expenses for Session of 1916. [*Which unfavorable report was adopted.*]

Also unfavorably the following order by Br. Zihlman: Ordered, That the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100) each be paid to W. O. Anderson, Jr., and W. E. Rowens, Jr., reporters for the daily press, for services rendered the Senate; same to be taken from the appropriation made by the Acts of 1914 for the Legislature of 1916. Ellers be paid for seven hundred hours' work overtime during this session as electrician and other services rendered, at sixty cents per hour, making a total of four hundred and twenty dollars (\$420).
