six per centum per annum, for the purpose of paying for said purchase and for making repairs and necessary improvements in the Market House Building, and to execute a mortgage on said building, including the leasehold interest purchased, to secure the payment of the semi-annual interest and the principal sum of six thousand dollars within a period of fifteen years."
