

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS.

By the President: A Bill entitled "An Act to declare the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest contained in the will and codicil of John K. McCulloh, late of Bedford, Pennsylvania, deceased, to the Methodist Preachers' Aid Society of Baltimore." [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.*]

By Mr. Zihlman: Senate Bill No. 106, entitled "An Act to refund to Mrs. A. M. E. Laney, of Allegany county, a sum of money erroneously paid by her for State taxes in the years 1911, 1912, 1913 and 1914." [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.*]

By Mr. Zihlman: Senate Bill No. 107, entitled "An Act to repeal Section 49 of Article 33 of the Code of Public General Laws of 1904, title 'Elections,' sub-title 'Nominations,' and to repeal Sections 55, 56, 58 and 59 of the Code of Public General Laws of 1904, title 'Elections,' sub-title 'Ballots and Ballot Boxes,' and to re-enact, with amendments, said Sections 49, 55 and 59." [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Elections.*]

By Mr. Zihlman: Senate Bill No. 108, entitled "An Act to prohibit any minister of the Gospel or other person in Allegany county, who is now or may hereafter be authorized under the laws of Maryland to perform the marriage ceremony, to give, directly or indirectly, to any person any fee as an inducement to bring any persons contemplating marriage to him for the purpose of performing the marriage ceremony." [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.*]

By the President: Senate Bill No. 109, entitled "An Act to make an appropriation for repairs to the Iceboat 'Annapolis,' and toward the expense of its maintenance and operation." [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.*]

By Mr. Archer: Senate Bill No. 110, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 7 of Article 81 of Bagby's Annotated Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Revenue and Taxes,' sub-title 'Exemptions,' as enacted by Chapter 467 of the Acts of the General Assembly of
