WHEREAS, Due notice of this resolution has been given; and

WHEREAS, It is rumored that one or more Bills will be offered during this session to annex a portion of Anne Arundel county to the City of Baltimore; and

WHEREAS, It is only just and proper that the Senator from Anne Arundel county should be a member of the Committee to which Bills proposing annexation to the city are referred, in order that he may become familiar with the reasons advanced for city extension; therefore, be it

Resolved, That the name of Senator Duvall, of Anne Arundel county, be added to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings, who, as a member thereof, shall be entitled to participate in all deliberations on the question of annexation of additions to Baltimore city and to vote on all such questions.

By Mr. Norris: Ordered, That all annexation Bills relating to territory contiguous to Baltimore city be referred to a committee on annexation of eleven Senators, to be appointed by the President, of which the present Committee on Judicial Proceedings shall constitute a part of said committee of eleven. INTRODUCTION OF BILLS.

By Mr. Jones: Senate Bill No. 116, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 477 of Article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Montgomery County,' sub-title 'Roads,' as contained in Chapter 790 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1912, so as to prohibit obstructions being placed on any public road and highway within said county, and to provide penalties therefor." [Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.]

By Mr. Brown: Senate Bill No. 117, entitled "An Act to authorize and direct the State Roads Commission to construct a highway in Kent county, between Still Pond Station and Urieville schoolhouse." [Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.]

By Mr. Archer: Senate Bill No. 118, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 3 of Article 39 of Bagby's Annotated Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Fish and Fisheries,' sub-title 'Head of Bay,'
