

Section 8-A, for the purpose of authorizing the State Treasurer to accept collateral surety on the bond of any bank acting as a depository for the funds of the State Treasurer." [Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.]

By Mr. Frick: Senate Bill No. 128, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 17 of Article 23 of the Code of Public General Laws (Bagby), Section 24 of said article, as repealed and re-enacted by Chapter 723 of the Acts of 1914, and Section 36 of said article." [Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Elections.]

By Mr. Frick: Senate Bill No. 129, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 78 of Article 33 of the Code of Public General Laws (Bagby)." [Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Elections.]

By Mr. Ogden: Senate Bill No. 130, entitled "An Act to amend the Constitution of Maryland by repealing Article 16, title 'The Referendum,' and re-enacting the same, so as to provide for 'The Initiative and Referendum,' and to provide for the submission of the said amendment to the qualified voters of the State for adoption or rejection." [Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Amendments to the Constitution.]

By Mr. Ogden: Senate Bill No. 131, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 443 of Article 4 of the Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'City of Baltimore,' sub-title 'Fines and Forfeitures,' as repealed and re-acted by Chapter 18 of the Acts of 1908." [Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.]

By Mr. Frick: Senate Bill No. 132, entitled "An Act to declare the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest contained in the will of Alice V. Reelkey, deceased, to the consistory of the First Reformed Church of Baltimore city." [Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.]

By the President: Senate Bill No. 133, entitled "An Act to declare the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland to the sale, grant and conveyance to the St. Luke's Reformed Church of Baltimore city, a body corporate duly incorporated, by Patrick J. McEvoy and Annie R. McEvoy,
