By Mr. Johnson: Senate Bill No. 221, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 40 of Article 56 of the Annotated Code of Public Civil Laws of Maryland (1912), title 'Licenses,' sub-title 'Traders.'" [Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.]

By Mr. Johnson: Senate Bill No. 222, entitled "An Act to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Howard county to levy annually a sum of money to construct roads in said county; providing for a special tax upon property in said county especially benefited by improved road construction, and to authorize the County Commissioners and the County Collector to perform certain duties as to said special tax." [Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Johnson, Jones and Holmead.]

By Mr. Johnson: Senate Bill No. 223, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 379 and 380 of Article 81 of the Public Civil Laws of Maryland (Bagby's Code), title 'Corporations,' sub-title 'Trust, Security and Fidelity Companies.'" [Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.]

By Mr. Johnson: Senate Bill No. 224, entitled "An Act to repeal Section 48 of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Public Civil Laws of Maryland (1912), title 'Revenue and Taxes,' sub-title 'Collectors and Collection,' and to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 72 of said Article 81 of said Code, title 'Revenue and Taxes,' sub-title 'Taxes—When Due,'" [Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.]

By Mr. Johnson: Senate Bill No. 225, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 66, 67, 68, 69, 70, 71, 72, 73, 74, 75, 76, 77, 78, 79, 80, 81 (Section 81 as amended, Chapter 121 of the Acts of 1912), of Article 81, Code of Public Civil Laws of Maryland, 1912, title 'Surveyor and State Survey,' sub-title 'Public Roads.'" [Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.]

By Mr. Johnson: Senate Bill No. 226, entitled "An Act to add four additional sections to Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, title 'Revenue and Taxes,' sub-title 'Tax on Gross Receipts of Certain Corporations,' said additional section to come in after Section 167, and to be designated as
