

due; and further authorizing the said Mayor and Town Council to make such further extension to said system from time to time within the corporate limits of said town as in their judgment may seem fit and proper; to incur indebtedness therefor; provide for the time of payment of the debt incurred and to pay for the same by a special levy on the abutting property to said water and sewer mains and on the assessable property of said town of Kensington, in the same manner as now levied and collected by said town of Kensington for redemption of its bonds, and payment of interest thereon, issued and sold for the purpose of installing said water and sewer system." [Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Jones, Holmead and Johnson.]

By Mr. Parsons: Senate Bill No. 230, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, those portions of Sections 20 and 21 of Chapter 472 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the year 1914, relating to the time for shooting, catching, killing or hunting for or having in possession, dead or alive, any partridge, quail, dove, woodcock, squirrel or rabbit within the limits of Somerset county." [Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Fish and Game.]
