

“Strike out all after the word ‘bond’ in line 20 of page 2 of the printed Bill and insert, in lieu thereof, the following: ‘Any such bank that may heretofore have given the bond, as heretofore provided by law, may at any time secure the cancellation of said bond and the substitution of a bond with such securities as are hereinbefore provided for, and any such bank may at any time, withdraw from the State Treasurer such collateral securities with the bond to which the securities are attached and file, in lieu thereof, such bonds as have heretofore been accepted by the State Treasurer; provided that no substitution of a bond with collateral or a bond with other securities for a bond with collateral shall be made oftener than once in each twelve months.’”

“Insert the words ‘or Trust Company’ in the following places: After the word ‘Bank’ in the title of the Bill. After the word ‘Bank’ in line 1 of Section 8-A on page 1 of printed Bill. After the word ‘Bank’ in line 6 of page 1 of printed Bill. After the word ‘Bank’ in line 9 of page 1 of the printed Bill. After the word ‘Bank’ on line 16 of page 2 of the printed Bill. After the word ‘Bank’ on line 20 of page 2 of the printed Bill.”

“In line 2 of Section 1 on page 1 of the printed Bill insert after the word ‘to’ the words ‘Article 90 of.’”

Amendment proposed by Committee: “Amend page 15, Section 654, line 21 of the printed Bill, by inserting after the words ‘three months,’ at the end of the sentence a comma, and the following: ‘except that any sentence under Section 414 of Article 27 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, title “Crimes and Punishment” sub-title “Railroads—Obstructing,” may be imposed in accordance with the provisions of said Section 414.’”

“Amend page 15, Section 655, line 17, by inserting after the words ‘three months,’ a comma, and the following: ‘except that any sentence under Section 414 of Article 27 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, title “Crimes and Punishment,” sub-title “Railroads—Obstructing,” may be imposed in accordance with the provisions of said Section 414.’”
