By Mr. Ogden: Senate Bill No. 326, entitled "An Act to add a new article to the Annotated Code of Maryland and to repeal Sections 134, 144, 145, 146, 147, 148, 149, 150 (as amended by Section 140-H of Chapter 133 of the Acts of 1912), 151, 152, 153, 154, 155, 158 and 160 of Article 56 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, title 'Licenses,' sub-title 'Motor Vehicles,' and Sections 140, 140-H, 141 of Article 56 of the Code of 1904, as amended by Chapter 133 of the Acts of 1912 and re-enact said sections; said new Article to be known as Article CII, title 'Road Traffic,' with appropriate sub-titles, the same providing regulations for the control of traffic of all kinds upon the roads in the State of Maryland."
