Out of 3,823, 3,105 were seized in the dry States of Alabama, Georgia, North and South Carolina and Tenessee. [Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Temperance.]

ORDERS.

By Mr. Duvall: Ordered, by the Senate, that the President appoint two members of the Senate, who in co-operation with two members of the House of Delegates, to be appointed by the Speaker thereof, and two members of the Third House, will form a committee to arrange and conduct the General Assembly Ball to be held at Annapolis during this Session. By Mr. Archer, by request: Senate Bill No. 358, entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 33 of the Code of Public Civil Laws of Maryland, title 'Elections,' subtitle 'Registration,' said new section to follow Section 30 and to be known as Section 30-A." [Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Elections.]
