

By Mr. Johnson: Senate Bill No. 375, entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 23 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, to be known as Section 88-G, relating to capital stock and franchise taxes upon and respecting building associations, and to repeal all other laws and sections and all other parts of laws and sections, so far as the same or any of the same may conflict, or be inconsistent with the provisions of this Act." [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.*]

By Mr. Johnson: Senate Bill No. 376, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 1, 6, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 51, 52 and 53 of Article 56 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, title 'Licenses,' and to repeal Section 54 of said Article 56 of said Code; and to also repeal Section 63 of Article 17 of said Code, title 'Clerks of Courts,' sub-title 'Clerks of Circuit Courts'; said section relating to granting of licenses." By Mr. Jones: Senate Bill No. 377, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 245 of Article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Montgomery County,' sub-title 'Garrett Park,' as the same was enacted by Chapter 790 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, 1912." [*Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Jones, Holmead and Johnson.*]
