title 'Insurance Department,' by repealing and re-enacting, with amendments, Sections 218 and 220, and by adding two new and additional sections thereto, said new sections to follow immediately after Section 219, and to be designated and known as Sections 219-A and 219-B, said new sections and said amended sections relating to the licensing and license fees of insurance brokers and broker's solicitors and providing penalties for violation of laws relating thereto." [Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Insurance, Fidelity, Security and Loan Companies.]

By Mr. Norris: Senate Bill No. 404, entitled "An Act requesting, authorizing and empowering the Board of Police Commissioners of Baltimore city to reinstate Anthony W. Schaelle as a member of the Police Force of Baltimore city." [Which was read the first time and referred to the City Senators.]

By Mr. Harrison: Senate Bill No. 405, entitled "An Act to authorize the issue of certificates of indebtedness of the State of Maryland for one million dollars (\$1,000,000), appropriating the same for the use of the trustees of the Maryland State College of Agriculture for the sole and only purpose of providing buildings and equipment for the said college, necessary to enable the said college to broaden and enlarge its facilities for education in both regular and special courses in all phases of agriculture, animal husbandry, horticulture, rural economics, domestic science, military science, rural engineering, rural sanitation, farm mechanics, farm drainage and also for the training of teachers in these subjects, and the further development of the facilities for agricultural education, investigation, demonstration and extension by the Maryland State College of Agriculture, as authorized by the Charter of said college and as outlined and required by the several Acts passed by the United States Congress providing for these several lines of work." [Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.]

By Mr. Harrison: Senate Bill No. 406, entitled "An Act to refund to certain corporations, moneys erroneously paid by them into the State's Treasury." [Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.]

By Mr. Harrison: Senate Bill No. 407, entitled "An Act providing for the making of appropriations for the maintenance of the Maryland State College of Agriculture, the Maryland Agricultural Experiment Station, and the Maryland Agri-
