and if the certificate is issued in any month after January, one-twelfth is to be deducted from each of the charges above stated for each expired month, but not fractions of a month."

"On page 14 of printed Bill, on line 30, strike out 'quar-

terly' and insert 'monthly.'"

"On page 25 of the printed Bill, on line 9, after the word 'convicted,' place a comma and insert 'of a greater speed than thirty-five miles an hour.'"

"On page 29 strike out 'Section 158, entitled "Garage-keeper's Lien." '"
