

erect and maintain a drawbridge over South River, from Taylorsville on the south side of said river, in the First District of said county, to Tucker's Landing on the north side of said river, in the Second District of said county; to issue bonds not exceeding \$25,000, for the purpose of constructing said bridge; to levy annually a sum on the taxable property of said county to provide for the maintenance of said bridge, and to retire said bonds as they mature, and to authorize said County Commissioners to make rules and regulations for the use of said bridge and protection of same." [*Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Duvall, Johnson and Ogden.*]

By Mr. Duvall: Senate Bill No. 452, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 1 of Chapter 173 of the Acts of 1910, as repealed and re-enacted by Section 1 of Chapter 26 of the Acts of 1912, relating to a ferry over South River from Taylorsville to Tucker's Landing, in Anne Arundel county." [*Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Duvall, Ogden and Johnson.*]

By Mr. Collier: Senate Bill No. 453, entitled "An Act to empower civil engineers and surveyors to enter and work upon private lands for the purpose of making surveys and examinations for the purpose of gathering data for proposed public or municipal works or improvements thereto." [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.*]

By Mr. Legg: Senate Bill No. 454, entitled "An Act to authorize and direct the State Roads Commission to construct a highway in Queen Anne's and Kent counties, between the towns of Ingleside and Masseys, Maryland." [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.*]

By Mr. Norris: Senate Bill No. 455, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 197 of Article 23 of the Annotated Code of Public Civil Laws of Maryland (legalized by Chapter 21 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1912), title 'Corporations,' sub-title 'Insurance Department,' relating to fraudulent practices by agents, solicitors, physicians and other persons in relation to insurance and insurance companies." [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Insurance, Fidelity, Security and Loan Companies.*]
