No. 7—"In Section 26, line 26 of the printed Bill, strike out the word 'years' in insert in lieu thereof the word 'year.'"

No. 8—"In Section 72, line 2 of the printed Bill, after the word 'appoint,' insert the words 'during the month of May'; in line 3 of the same section strike out the words 'Monday in May' and insert in lieu thereof the words 'day of August.'"

No. 9—"In Section 75, line 2 of the printed Bill, strike out the word 'bi-annual' and insert in lieu thereof the word 'biennial.'"

No. 10—"In Section 68, line 15 of the printed Bill, strike out all after the word 'schools,' the first four words of line 16, all of line 19, after the word 'schools'; all of lines 20 and 21, and the word 'further,' in line 22."

No. 11—"In Section 128, line 16 of the printed Bill, strike out the word 'construction' and insert in lieu thereof the word 'instruction.'"

No. 12—"In Section 136, line 2 of the printed Bill, strike out the word 'expense' and insert in lieu thereof the word 'expenses.'"

No. 13—"In Section 138, line 2 of the printed Bill, strike out the figures '135' and insert in lieu thereof the figures '133'; and in line 10 of the same section strike out the word 'bi-annual' and insert in lieu thereof the word 'bi-ennial.'"

No. 14—"In Section 139, line 5 of the printed Bill, strike out the figures '135' and insert in lieu thereof the figures '133'"

No. 15—"In Section 18, line 2 of the printed Bill, after the word 'years,' insert the following: 'and said Board shall fix his salary and pay same from the appropriation for the expenses and maintenance of the State Department of Education.'"

No. 16—"At the end of Section 129 of the printed Bill, strike out the period and insert the following: 'provided said graduate pursued the academic course in the high school.'"

No. 17—"On page 39 of the printed Bill, at the end of Section 55, insert the following paragraph:

12. Any graduate of the department of pedagogy of any standard college or university maintaining a department of pedagogy, that has been approved by the State Board of Education of Maryland, shall be entitled to teach in the public elementary or high schools of the State of Maryland without examination. The diploma of said graduate shall be rated as a first-grade teacher's certificate and be subject to classification
