

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS.

By Mr. Duvall: Senate Bill No. 485, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 111 of Article 2 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Anne Arundel County,' sub-title 'Coroners,' and relating to physicians' charges for post-mortems and autopsies." [*Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Duvall, Johnson and Ogden.*]

By Mr. Duvall: Senate Bill No. 486, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 186 of Article 2 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Anne Arundel County,' sub-title 'Orphans' Court,' as repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, by Chapter 95 of the Acts of 1892 and by Chapter 109 of the Acts of 1902." [*Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Duvall, Johnson and Ogden.*]

By Mr. Shepherd: Senate Bill No. 487, entitled "An Act to authorize the State Librarian, by and with the consent and approval of the Library Committee of the Maryland State Library, to sell, or otherwise dispose of, some books and documents now in said library, not deemed necessary or desirable to be retained in said library, and to pay over the proceeds of such sales to the State Treasurer." [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.*]

By Mr. Legg: Senate Bill No. 488, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 124 of Article 56 of Bagby's Annotated Code of Public Civil Laws of Maryland, title 'Licenses,' sub-title 'Telegraph and Express Companies.'" [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.*]

By Mr. Speicher, by request: Senate Bill No. 489, entitled "An Act to authorize the Board of Public Works to sell the State's interest in and to seventeen acres of land known as Lake Brown, situate, lying and being in Garrett county, State of Maryland." [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.*]

By Mr. Bomberger: Senate Bill No. 490, entitled "An Act to repeal sub-divisions c and d of paragraph 3 of Section 13 of Chapter 731 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the year 1912, entitled 'An Act to revise the child labor laws of this State by repealing Section 4 of Article 100
