[*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.*]

Also House Bill No. 368, entitled "An Act to extend the provisions of Chapter 541 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, Session of 1914, entitled 'An Act to add a new section to Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Elections," sub-title "Registration"; said new section to be known as Section 29-B and to apply only to Caroline county, to Worcester county, so that the same shall apply to Worcester and Caroline counties.'" [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Elections.*]

Also House Bill No. 468, entitled "An Act to change the district lines of Election District No. 10, Precinct No. 1, and Election District No. 10, Precinct No. 2, and Election District No. 27, in Allegany county, Maryland." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Elections.*]

Also House Bill No. 498, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 2 of Chapter 110 of the Act of Assembly of Maryland of 1807, entitled 'An Act to incorporate the contributors to the Baltimore General Dispensary.'" [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.*]

Also House Bill No. 554, entitled "An Act to authorize and direct the Board of County Commissioners of Charles county, Maryland, to turn over to the Board of County School Commissioners of said county certain moneys, known as the 'Dog Tax Fund,' to be used by them in the building of new school-houses." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Mudd, Chesley and Holmead.*]

Also House Bill No. 509, entitled "An Act to create an additional election district to be known as District No. 29, Allegany county, Maryland." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Zihlman, Speicher and Kaufman.*]
