

Also House Bill No. 482, entitled "An Act to add a new section to Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, as the same was amended and re-enacted by Chapter 123 of the Acts of 1898, title 'City of Baltimore,' sub-title 'Police Commissioners,' said new section to come under said sub-title and to follow immediately after Section 777-C, and to be known and designated as Section 777-D." Also House Bill No. 453, entitled "An Act to amend the Charter of the Baltimore Chamber of Commerce by providing for classification and regulation of its membership." Also House Bill No. 484, entitled "An Act to provide for the further existence of the charter and corporate existence of the Monocacy and Urbana Turnpike Road Company of Frederick county, a corporation formed under the provisions of Article 23 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, entitled 'Corporations,' and to amend its charter and give further powers." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.*]
