

Chapters 183 and 434 of the Acts of 1868, Chapters 88, 78, 242 and 419 of the Acts of 1870, Chapter 176 of the Acts of 1874, Chapter 339 of the Acts of 1878, Chapter 429 of the Acts of 1882, Chapters 279, 299 and 481 of the Acts of 1890, and Chapter 430 of the Acts of 1906; the same being designed to repeal all continuing appropriations to colleges, academies and schools included in what is commonly known as the 'Academic Fund.'" [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.*]

Also House Bill No. 637, entitled "An Act to authorize the Board of County School Commissioners of Anne Arundel county to borrow money on the credit of Anne Arundel county to erect, heat and furnish annexes or additions to the following public schools in said county: School 13, District 3; School 2, District 3; School 15, District 3; School 4, District 3; School 6, District 3; School 7, District 3; School 1, District 3; School 4, District 1; School 10, District 4." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Duvall, Ogden and Johnson.*]

Also House Bill No. 492, entitled "An Act to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Sections 18, 19 and 20 of Article 19, Chapter 753, Acts 1906, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'St. Mary's County,' sub-title 'Birds, Game and Foxes.'" [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Fish and Game.*]

Also House Bill No. 646, entitled "An Act authorizing and directing the State Roads Commission to make a survey and estimate of the cost of construction of a State Highway between Grove and Bureau, in Caroline county." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.*]

Also House Bill No. 643, entitled "An Act to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Allegany county to borrow money on the credit of said county to pay for the erection of new school buildings and for additions to and improvements of school buildings in Allegany county and to issue bonds therefor, and to levy on the assessable property in Allegany county an annual tax sufficient to pay said bonds as they mature, and to pay the interest thereon, as it becomes due."
