[*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Williams, Cooper and Archer.*]

Also House Bill No. 165, entitled "An Act to authorize the Treasurer of the State of Maryland and the Board of County Commissioners of Baltimore county to refund to James W. Shea, certain moneys for an unused retail liquor dealer's license." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.*]

Also House Bill No. 8, entitled "An Act to authorize and direct the Comptroller of the State Treasury to refund to Abraham A. Windeshein, money paid by him for auctioneer license granted to him, which was never used." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.*]

Also House Bill No. 26, entitled "An Act to repeal Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26 and 27 of Chapter 514 of the Acts of Assembly of Maryland of 1910, as the same were repealed and re-enacted by Chapter 457 of the Acts of Assembly of 1912, and by Chapter 357 of the Acts of Assembly of Maryland of 1914, and to re-enact, with amendments, Sections 2 to 22, both inclusive; the said re-enacted sections being a new charter for the town of Mount Rainier, in Prince George's county, Maryland."
