

No. 5—"On page 1 of the printed Bill, in Section 9, in line 8, insert the word 'or' after the word 'member' and before the words 'by judgment.'"

No. 6—"On page 2 of the printed Bill, in Section 9, in line 16, insert the words 'and any such' before the word 'judgment' at the beginning of said line and insert the word 'or' after the word 'judgment' and before the word 'decree' and strike out the words 'or promissory note.'"

No. 7—"On page 2 of the printed Bill, in Section 9, in line 17, insert the word 'such' after the word 'any' and before the word 'corporation.'"

No. 8—"On page 2 of the printed Bill, in Section 9, in line 20, insert the words 'and in' after the words 'ordinary mortgages' and before the word 'judgment,' and strike out the word 'judgment' and insert in lieu thereof the word 'judgments.'"

No. 9—"On page 1 of the printed Bill, in Section 9, strike out the words 'or by' at the end of line 9, and in line 10 strike out the following words 'the indorsement of a promissory note.'"

No. 10—"On page 2 of the printed Bill, in Section 9, in line 21, strike out the words 'promissory notes,' and insert in lieu thereof the words 'loans on hypothecated stock.'"

SUBJECT: ROAD—MONTGOMERY COUNTY.

Amendment proposed by Committee: "Strike out Section 1 of the printed Bill and insert in lieu thereof the following:

'Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the State Roads Commission of Maryland shall take over and include as a part of its system the public road leading from Brown's corner on the Colesville-Ashton Pike, in Montgomery county, via Spencerville, to State Road No. 1 at Laurel, in Prince George's county, provided that the State Roads Commission shall not be required to maintain said road until it shall have been constructed as are other State roads, but until such time, it shall be maintained and kept up as at present.'"
