SUBJECT: REGISTRATION OF NURSES.

Amendments proposed by Committee:

No. 1—"In the fifth line of the title of the printed Bill, after the words 'Session of 1904,' and before the words 'to provide for,' insert the following: 'and to add and enact two new sections thereto, to follow, respectively, Sections 205 and 207, and be designated, respectively, Sections 205-A and 207-A, said two new sections relating to issuing of certificates of registration to registered nurses of other States and the appointment or employment of a visiting nurse.'"

No. 2—"Strike out the word 'trained' appearing in Section 5, line 28 of the printed Bill."

No. 3—"Strike out the word 'trained' appearing in Section 5, line 34 of the printed Bill."

No. 4—"Strike out the word 'trained' appearing in Section 6, line 6 of the printed Bill."
