any persons contemplating marriage to him for the purpose of performing the marriage ceremony."

Senate Bill No. 27, entitled "An Act to authorize the President and Commissioners of Chesapeake City, Maryland, to issue bonds to pay off the present indebtedness of said town, growing out of a suit of Mrs. Josephine Pryor and others, and to pay for improvements hereafter to be made in and to the said town of Chesapeake City at the direction of the said the President and Commissioners of said town."
