

167-A'; and Chapter 336 of the Acts of 1902, entitled 'An Act to repeal Section 161 of Article 23 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Wicomico County," sub-title "Sharptown," relating to election of commissioners'; also to repeal Section 167 of Article 23 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Wicomico County,' sub-title 'Sharptown,' relating to the powers and duties of the commissioners, as repealed and re-enacted by Chapter 421 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, January Session of 1894, and to re-enact the same, with amendments; and Chapter 363 of the Acts of 1904, entitled 'An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 165 of Article 23 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Wicomico County," sub-title "Sharptown," relating to appointment of a clerk.'" [Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."] [Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Bennett, Harrison and Shepherd.]

Also House Bill No. 689, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 11 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Maryland of 1908, being Section 11 of Article 48 of Bagby's Code of Public Civil Laws of Maryland, title 'Inspectors,' sub-title 'Tobacco.'" [Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."] [Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Inspections.]

Also House Bill No. 706, entitled "An Act to amend Chapter 833 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at its Session of 1914, title 'An Act to amend the charter of Preston, by repealing Sections 1 to 27, inclusive, of Chapter 689 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland for the year 1892, being "An Act to incorporate the town of Preston in Caroline county," and all amendments and additions thereto, except as hereinafter retained and preserved, and to re-enact the same, with amendments,' by adding a new section thereto, to be known as Section 15-A.'" [Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."] [Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Collier, Legg and Cooper.]

Also House Bill No. 713, entitled "An Act to authorize the Burgess and Commissioners of Williamsport, in Washington county, in the State of Maryland, to purchase from Potomac Fire Company No. 1, of Williamsport, Maryland, certain real estate within the corporate limits of the town of Williamsport, and to levy taxes for the payment of the purchase money therefor." [Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."] [Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Bomberger, Kaufman and Zihlman.]
