thereby, insert the following: 'provided, however, that nothing in this section shall be taken or construed as classifying any of the above mentioned corporations as ordinary business corporations, if such corporations construct, maintain or operate properties, lines or works within the State.'" [Which amendment was read and adopted.] [Which favorable report was read the second time and ordered printed for a third reading.]
