propriated,' and after the words 'to levy,' and before the words 'for the same' in the last line of the first clause of the title insert the words 'an additional sum.'" [Which was read and adopted.]

"At the end of Section 5 add the following: 'not exceeding the sum of \$2,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1917, for the erection of said hospital, and the further sums of \$1,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1917, and \$1,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1918, for the maintenance and support of the same." [Which was read and adopted.]

"At the end of Section 3 add the following: 'provided that said hospital shall not be located on the Almshouse Farm or any part thereof, nor on the land commonly known as 'Stormont.'" [Which was read and adopted.]

"In Section 4, line 2 of the printed Bill, strike out the figures '\$3,500' and insert in lieu thereof '\$2,500.'" [Which was read and adopted.]

[Which favorable report was adopted, which was read the second time and ordered printed for a third reading.]
