Murphy to construct in front of their land on Tedious Creek, in Straits Election District, in Dorchester county, Maryland, a wharf or road extending out into the waters of Tedious Creek, an arm of Fishing Bay.” [*Endorsed: “Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays.”*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Shepherd, Collier and Legg.*]

Also House Bill No. 772, entitled “An Act to authorize and empower the Board of Police Commissioners of Baltimore city, or its successor in office, to reopen and retry the case of Gerhard Hauptman, an ex-patrolman of the police force of Baltimore city, and to reinstate the said Gerhard Hauptman as a member of the said police force if, in its judgment, it shall deem the same proper or expedient.” [*Endorsed: “Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays.”*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the City Senators.*]

Also House Bill No. 775, entitled “An Act to authorize the State Board of Education to pay to Minnie A. Murphy, of Howard county, a pension, as provided in Section 58 of Chapter 605 of the Acts of 1908, for teachers who have served for twenty-five years.” [*Endorsed: “Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays.”*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.*]

Also House Bill No. 669, entitled “An Act to add five new sections to Article 27 of the Code of Public General Laws, subtitle ‘Crimes and Punishments,’ to be known as Sections 484, 485, 486, 487 and 488 and to follow immediately after Section 483 thereof, making it unlawful to separate or cause to be separated any child under six months of age from its mother for the purpose of placing such child in a foster home or institution, or to place, receive or retain such child in a foster home or institution, and to regulate the manner and circumstances under which it may be done, and to provide a penalty for the violation of said Act; the same to read as follows:.” [*Endorsed: “Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays.”*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.*]
