Also House Bill No. 197, entitled "An Act to add a new section to Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, title 'Elections,' sub-title 'Primary Elections,' said section to follow immediately after Section 182-A of said Article, as the same is codified in Volume 3 of said Code, to be known as Section 182-B, and providing for a registration and transfer day preceding all primary elections." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Elections.*]

Also House Bill No. 771, entitled "An Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay James G. Boss, Jr., for legal services rendered the State in maintaining two suits—one of the State of Maryland vs. William P. Cole, Clerk of the Circuit Court for Baltimore county, and the other of the State of Maryland against the Western Union Telegraph Company of Baltimore city." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.*]

Also House Bill No. 828, entitled "An Act to add a new section to Article 13 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Harford County,' sub-title 'Havre de Grace,' to be known as Section 168-A; providing for the erection of gasoline tanks on the sides of the streets or roads of the city of Havre de Grace upon the payment of an annual license and complying with certain other conditions." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Archer, Cooper and Norris.*]

Also House Bill No. 778, entitled "An Act to extend the corporate existence, privileges and powers of the Hyattsville Building Association, of Hyattsville, Prince George's county, Maryland, a corporation incorporated under the general laws of this State." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.*]

Also House Bill No. 588, entitled "An Act to refund to John C. Lamar the sum of money paid in error to the State Treasury." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.*]
