

Also House Bill No. 707, entitled "An Act to add an additional Section to Article 17 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland (Bagby's Code), title 'Clerks of Courts,' sub-title 'General Duties of Clerks,' to be known as Section 2-B, providing for the recording of conditional contracts of sale and compensation for the same." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.*]

Also House Bill No. 779, entitled "An Act to provide that whenever in Montgomery county a street or electric railway car, operating on tracks which occupy a portion of a roadway or run parallel with and alongside of a roadway, is standing for the purpose of receiving or discharging passengers, all vehicles shall come to a halt at least fifteen feet from such car, and remain standing until such car is again in motion, and to provide penalty for violations." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.*]

Also House Bill No. 820, entitled "An Act to create a commission to consider and report to the Governor on the advisability of establishing a central place for the execution of condemned felons and to recommend the location of said place, and further to embrace in said report a recommendation changing the prevailing method of capital punishment of death by hanging to electrocution, if said commission deem it advisable; said report to include plans and measures to carry out the recommendations of said commission." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.*]

Also House Bill No. 869, entitled "An Act to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Harford county to levy annually a sum of money for the support of Vincent Burkins, of said county." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Archer, Cooper and Norris.*]

Also House Bill No. 248, entitled "An Act to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Sections 126, 127, 128 and 129 of Article 93 of the Annotated Code of Public General Laws of Maryland of 1911 (Bagby's Code), title 'Testamentary Law,' sub-title 'Distribution.'" [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.*]
